What can you expect as a Dog Kennel Assistant volunteer?

Duties include:

- Assist with various shelter responsibilities, including kennel cleaning, dishes, laundry, opening & closing responsibilities.
- Provide specialized dog enrichment opportunities, including exercising, quiet time, playtime, and distribution of enrichment items.
- Remove dogs from kennels for outdoor enrichment, socialization, and exercise.
- Acting as an ambassador for HSBV philosophies.
- Upholding excellent client service standards.
- Other duties as assigned.

How do I get started?

Training and Skill Development

1. Submit Volunteer Fee and Complete Volunteer Profile.
2. Complete Dog Handling Training.
3. Complete a Shelter Hands-On Training session.

Commitment: Regular shift of two hours weekly for six months (Example: Tuesdays from 8am - 10am)

Supervision: Supervision by the Volunteer Services Department.

Scheduling: Please notify the Humane Society of your absence with as much advanced notice as possible by visiting your volunteer page at www.myvolunteerpage.com and removing yourself from the shift under the "Schedule" tab. This will alert the Volunteer Services Department of your absence and make your shift available for a substitute to cover.
