Meet Bruno. He's one of three Beagles recently transferred to HSBV after being saved from an animal testing laboratory. While we don't know what his life looked like before he came to us, his eyes tell his story.

Bruno has complex needs. He would plop down on the floor, too scared to walk. Often, even our team's kindness and gentle encouragement wasn't enough to get him moving again. If you have a pet like this, you know that, with fear, the simplest act like taking a treat, becomes an impossible challenge.

Despite this, every day our team showed up for this sweet dog with lots of treats and patience. Some days, Bruno took the treats to the corner of his kennel. Other days, he wouldn't move, and our team would just sit with him. They knew what Bruno needed was time to adjust and space to build his confidence.

Giving dogs like Bruno a second chance isn't the "easy" thing to do. If it were easy, everyone would do it. It takes a lot of time, perseverance, love and commitment.

Animals are staying with us two days longer than last year. Two extra days may not seem like much, but for the 5,000 animals in our care each year, it means more time and resources. Behind each of these numbers is a life worth saving.

Bruno is in a loving home instead of a cage because you care. It's only through your kindness and compassion that we can continue this lifesaving work and ensure a better tomorrow for our animals.
