When this tiny two-month-old kitten first arrived at HSBV, his situation was heartbreaking, and his outlook was grim. He was brought in by our partners at animal protection after he was found at a construction site. His shoulder was crushed, and his severe wounds were badly infected.

For his first few days with us, fear ruled his world. He was hurting and kept his distance from anyone who tried to get close. We knew we had to fight for him. Despite his tremendous pain, we saw a spark in his young eyes. With patience and compassion, our veterinary team got to work cleaning his wounds, treating the infection and performing a lifesaving amputation to remove his injured leg.

As his pain subsided, a remarkable transformation began for this brave boy. His fears melted away, and his personality blossomed. With this joyful shift, Tonka soon showed that he trusted us, leaning in for pets and giving our staff and volunteers lots of purrs in return.




